


LINE: Create a poster that describes line. Use a variety of media (pencil crayons, markers, paper, and magazines) to create geometric and organic lines and label each one. Also find 2 photos in magazines that have a strong emphasis on LINE.



SHAPE: Cut a variety of geometric and organic shapes and label each one. Cut them out of construction paper and assemble them to create a human, animal or fantasy character.
Also find 2 magazine images that clearly emphasize shape and use them in your poster.




FORM:Cut out 3 photos from magazines showing organic form and label them. Cut out 3
photos from magazines showing geometric form and label them. Also draw 2 basic
forms and try to shade them to look 3-dimensional.



TEXTURE: Find **3 great close-up photographs showing texture** in magazines and include them in your poster. Also take a thin piece of paper and **make 3 "rubbings" to show 3 different types** of texture (examples: bottom of shoe, leaf, table top, back of chair).



SPACE: Find **3 landscape photographs in a magazine** that clearly define space. They must have a clear **background, middle ground and foreground**.



COLOUR: Create a colour wheel using pencil crayons and also find at least 3 photographs that clearly focus on colour.



VALUE: Create a grey scale in pencil with at least 8 steps. Cut out strips of solid colour from magazines and create a value scale using at least 5 boxes. Also add 2 photos from magazines of objects that have a strong light source showing value.
